

Bus Trip to Flight 93 September 21, 2019



Seventeen years and \$60 million later, the final phase of the Flight 93 National Memorial has been completed with the “Tower of Voices” that is 93-feet-tall and contains forty wind chimes, one each for the 40 Shanksville crash victims.

By popular request, we will return to the Flight 93 National Memorial on Saturday, September 21, 2019, leaving from the Crowne Plaza South at 8:00 AM and returning approximately 6:00PM. (164 Fort Couch Road, Bethel Park PA 15241. Please park on the far side of the lot away from the building so we do not interfere with hotel guests.) The cost is \$100 per person which includes a professional guide, all entrance fees, gratuities and plated lunch at the Coal Miner’s Café. Stops include Big Mac Museum, Flight 93 National Memorial, QueCreek Mine Rescue Site, and the Flight 93 Memorial Chapel. **All are welcome!**
